A Community Center for Windward?

Windward Lake Club met with members of the WCSA Board 3 weeks ago, to discuss a proposed **Community Center** adjacent to us - just this side of the dam. We liked the preliminary layout, in that it allows for flexible space for Team Meetings, Parties, Parent groups, Swim Meetings - virtually any social gathering from card groups to small weddings. Other interesting uses are being discussed, such as meetings with Alpharetta City Depts., Police, Fire, etc.

Plans are very preliminary, and you may read in this month's *Currents* the overall rationale for the project. In our humble opinion, it's long overdue! The additional highlight for us - the Center is positioned for great lake views from the outside decks - in effect, allowing all residents to enjoy the lake more.

Here are ongoing steps related to the Board community discussion regarding scale, function, cost, appearance & design, etc:

- 1) establish Steering Committee to evaluate information. A dozen residents have already signed on. Anyone interested?
- 2) WCSA has visited 8 existing Community Centers in the area. Findings, ideas, cautions, and the rationale for the project will publish in *Currents* this month.
- 3) The Board is visiting with Neighborhood groups, WHI, WWC, WOW, WYC, WARM, etc, to gain as much input as possible. If you want to invite WCSA Board members to join an informal group of yours, send them a note.
- 4) The *Mainsail* publication next month will include more Community Center specifics for review - proposed uses, basic architectural renderings, site plan with parking, and FAQ's.
- 5) Following all community input, a full mailing of the final plan, complete with costs, will be sent to each Windward resident in the fall. It will include a ballot, and potential next steps should we choose to move forward.
